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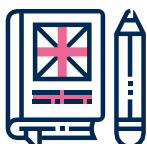
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KEY STAGE 3

The main aim of the curriculum for KS3 is to promote high standards of English, Maths, Science, History, ICT & Global Perspectives.



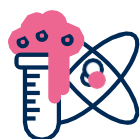
English
